

Article IV – Board of Directors

Current Text

Section 4. Removal of Directors. Any Director may be removed with cause, at any time, by a vote of two-thirds of the members of the Board present at any special meeting of the Board of Directors, who shall absent himself from three (3) consecutive meetings of the Board of Directors, of membership meetings, or any combination thereof, unless he shall offer at the next regular meeting of the Board of Directors an excuse satisfactory to said Board, shall be deemed to have resigned as a member of the Board of Directors and shall forthwith cease to a member thereof.

New Bylaw

Section 4. Removal of Directors. Any Director may be removed, with cause, ~~at any time, by after~~ a vote of two-thirds of the ~~board~~ members ~~of the Board~~ present at any special ~~or regular~~ meeting of the Board of Directors.; A Director who ~~is shall~~ absent ~~himself~~ from three (3) consecutive meetings (~~includes any combination of Regular board meetings, Special board meetings of the Board of Directors, of or~~ membership meetings), ~~or any combination thereof, unless he shall offer at the next regular meeting of the Board of Directors and does not offer~~ an excuse satisfactory to said Board, shall be deemed to have resigned as a member of the Board of Directors and his/her status as a Board Member shall ~~forthwith~~ cease ~~to a member forthwith~~ thereof.
