

Bylaw Change - Added ARTICLE I - Section 9

Proposed

Section 9. Associate Membership: A spouse or legal domestic partner residing at the same address of a member (here and after “Primary Member”) in good standing may join as an Associate Member for a fee of \$100.00 yearly dues and \$0 initiation. The prospective Associate Member must fill out a membership application, be voted in by the BOD, pay dues and attend a new member orientation before being accepted as an Associate Member.

The Associate Member may use all club facilities and hold club credentials usable without the Primary Member, may escort minor children/grandchildren and guests as per current policy, and may hunt on property only when accompanying the Primary Member.

The Associate Member may not vote in any meetings or elections or hold any elected position within the club. They also shall not be granted equity within the club. Years of service as an Associate Member do not count towards Life Membership or Elected Position requirements if the Membership is converted. In the event that the Primary Member is separated from the club (Death, Termination, Resignation), the Associate Member shall continue through to the next renewal period where they must convert to a Full Membership or the associate membership will end.

Associate Members may convert to a Full Membership at any time by paying the difference in owed dues as well as the current initiation fee.
