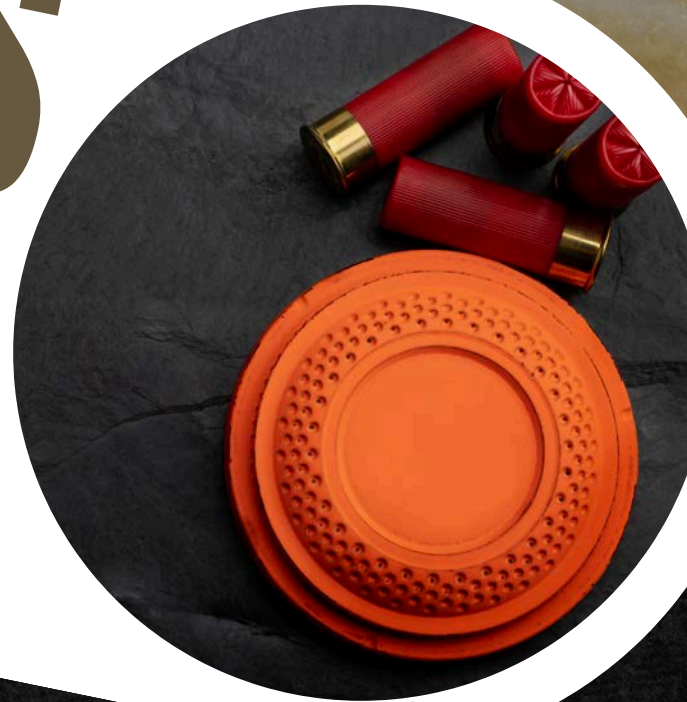

Hey - Ever wonder how the Tonawanda Sportsman's Club came to be? A little piece of history, thanks to Fred Rexford.

The Tonawandas Sportsmen's Club, Inc. was founded in 1947 by James Mead, Reynold Gombert, Norman Worth, and Gerald Getman. The original clubhouse was located next to the Niagara River in North Tonawanda until about 1953. The group purchased land in Pendleton beginning in 1948 and continued purchasing until they reached their current footprint of 262 acres. The original clubhouse was moved from the River Road location to Killian Road, and unfortunately the structure was destroyed by fire in 1961. The clubhouse we are in today was built in 1963.

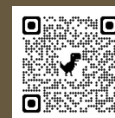
The club has a rich history and has been a central hub for its business operations and correspondence since its incorporation on June 23, 1947. The club is governed by the New York Department of State and maintains an active filing status.

The Tonawandas Sportsmen's Club is a not-for-profit corporation that offers a variety of outdoor recreational activities, including hunting, fishing, archery, and more. The club also provides a full-service kitchen and banquet hall for its members and guests.

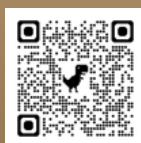

## Trap Shooting

In trap shooting, shooters stand in a line or in individual shooting stations arranged in a semicircle. The shooting stations are usually positioned at different angles from a central trap house.

In each round, shooters take turns calling for a target, and the trap machine randomly releases a clay target, sending it flying away from the trap house.

The objective is to break or shatter the clay target with a shotgun blast. Shooters are scored based on how many targets they hit out of the total number attempted.

## Skeet Shooting

Skeet shooting is typically done on a designated field with two trap houses, one high house and one low house. There are eight shooting stations arranged in a semicircle between these two houses.

In skeet shooting, targets are thrown from both the high and low houses in a specific pattern, with one high and one low target released simultaneously at different points along the field.

Shooters move between the stations in a predetermined order, taking shots at the targets as they fly across the field.

The objective is to break both the high and low targets for each station. Skeet shooting is known for its challenging crossing shots and requires quick target acquisition and accuracy.

5-STAND COMBINES THE CORE ASPECTS OF SKEET, SPORTING CLAYS AND TRAP SHOOTING.

CLAY-TARGET LAUNCHERS ARE STRATEGICALLY POSITIONED AROUND FIVE SHOOTING STATIONS, OR STANDS. THE LAUNCHERS THROW CLAY BIRDS FROM THE FRONT, BACK AND BOTH SIDES OF THE SHOOTER.

DURING A GAME OF 5-STAND, SHOOTERS ARE PRESENTED FIVE TARGETS AT EACH STATION FOR A TOTAL OF 25 TARGETS.

AFTER SHOOTING AT A STATION'S FIVE TARGETS, THE SHOOTER THEN MOVES ON TO THE NEXT STATION.

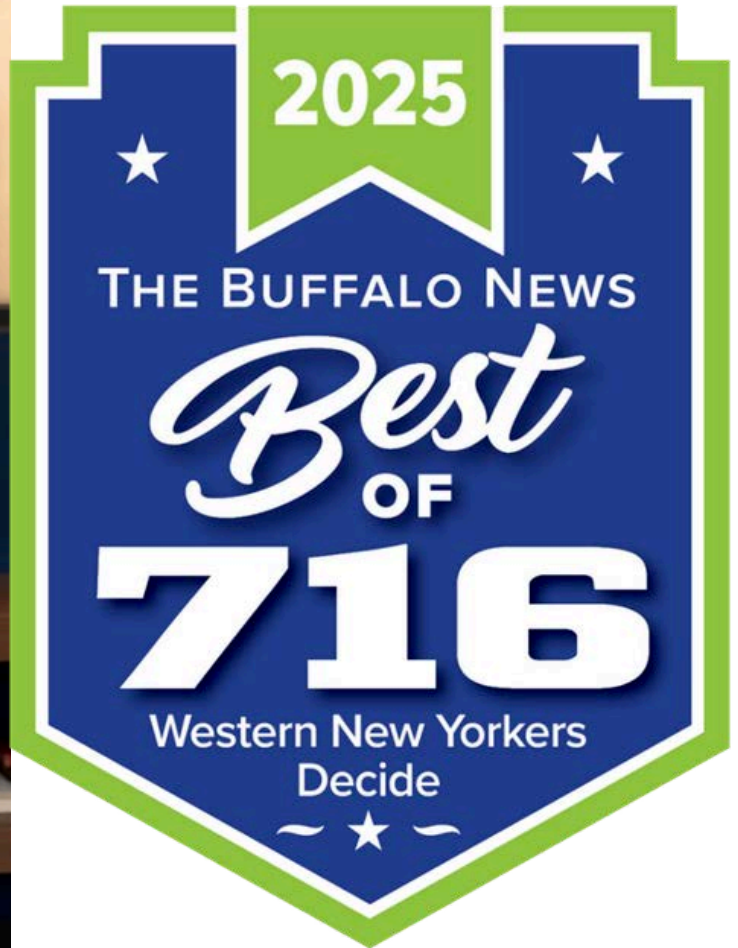

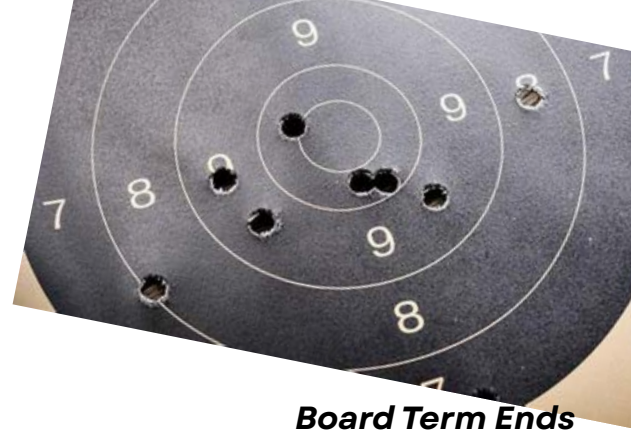
